Reminder - New meals system (from September)

Please remember that we are changing the way you buy school lunches for your Nursery and KS2 children from September. This will all be done online via our current payment system, Parentpay. Instead of buying books of tickets you will pay in and create a balance from which your child's meal will be deducted on a daily basis. You can therefore pay in as much as you would like. Under the new system you will also be able to log in and see which option your child has chosen and you can set up and receive a free email when your balance falls below an amount of your choice.

Please note that we will **not** be accepting dinner tickets in September and therefore we recommend that you check how many tickets you have at home and if you need to buy tickets only buy the number you will need to the end of term (Wednesday 25th July). The ability to purchase tickets will be removed on Friday 20th July.


