## Headteacher's News

### Information

#### **Swimschool**

Due to essential repairs to the roof at Middlemoor there will be no Swimschool for at least the next 2 weeks. We will let you know if the last session will take place on the 22nd July.

#### Absence due to sickness

If your child has been sick please consider whether your child has a D&V virus, whether it is food related or due to excitement or anxiety, Our Educational Welfare Officer has asked us to remind you that your child should only be kept off for 48 hours if the vomiting is due to a virus that could be spread throughout the school. If you are sure that the vomiting is food related or for another reason and will therefore not be spread, you may bring your child into school. We will of course monitor them and call you if they do need to go home.

When you call in or email to report an absence or illness please ensure you give the reason.

We need evidence of all medical appointments such as a hospital letter, Dr's appointment card (that must be signed by the Dr's receptionist) or a prescription. If your child is off school you can call your surgery and ask them to record your child's illness. Then on subsequent days if they are still off you can ask the surgery to print evidence of the call to give to the school or you can print it off yourself if you have online access to your medical records.
