Outstanding Actions: The pupil survey is being considered by the School Council and will be rolled out after half term. It will be a future agenda item. SP is looking at timings to carry out case studies. 6 17. **Leadership Report** KR and AF have continued to have TLO meetings but in a different way, splitting maths and literacy. Literacy focus is in classrooms, monitoring the learning environment and impact of PWP. KW has started as the maths lead, carrying out lesson observations and finding out strengths and weaknesses. She has drawn up an action plan. NM reported that the leadership report format is being considered as much of the information may be produced though SIMs, straight to CAST. CAST are working with Scomis to produce this report. A verbal update can take place at the next meeting. The meeting moved to part 2. Governor Reports from named leads: 8 18. (Statutory Grants / HR / RE & Catholic Life / SEND / Safeguarding / H&S / Finance / Parents and the Community / Curriculum and Standards) AB fed back from the recent RE visits and the report has been shared. The Collective Worship policy was discussed and will also be shared. [This is on Governorhub]. Governors saw that good plans are in place (such as the new Children's Chaplains) to develop the Catholic life of the school. Governors suggested a visit takes place to the classrooms to observe prayers. LW (who is Catholic) will take on the RE lead role on her return from maternity leave. 'Ten Ten' is a resource purchased by CAST to support us in delivering the new EPR curriculum. It includes a collective worship element. As a Catholic school we legally have to teach sex and relationship education. From September we have to teach about diversity and respecting differences. This will be taught from a Catholic perspective, using these new resources. We will continue to offer the parents workshops in summer term.
