Headteacher's News

Happy New Year and welcome back to a new school term!

Last year we received a grant due to the high number of pupils with additional needs within our school. We have used some of this grant to install a lovely new sensory room with cushions, lights and a huge therapy ball. This will help us to fulfil the sensory needs of our pupils.

The room will be officially opened next week by some of our pupils assisted by Raymond Friel, CEO of Plymouth CAST, Kevin Butlinthe Trust's new Director of Education and standards and Julia Foster- the head of Devon's 0-25 services. We have further exciting plans for use of this grant and will look forward to updating you as these happen.

Information

Increase in Prices - Nursery Hours and School Meals

Please note that from 1st January 2020 the price for a school meal will go up to £2.30. The minimum payment on Parentpay (5 meals) will therefore be £11.50.

Additional Nursery hours will increase to £4.20 per hour.

Curriculum Enrichment

We are committed to extending children's experiences beyond the classroom to bring the curriculum to life. Visitors to school, local trips within Exeter and inter-school activities all enrich children's learning and are often the most powerful experiences children have. Such activities do come at a cost and as you know, funding from the local authority has significantly declined.

We would like to ask parents (who have not already donated) for a <u>voluntary</u> contribution for the year to help us offer these activities and reduce the (sometimes very small) amounts that we collect from you. A suggested donation per child is £10. We would appreciate you paying by Parentpay but if you are unable to access this please send a cash or cheque made payable to "Plymouth CAST" in a SEALED envelope marked Curriculum Enrichment and your child's name and class. If you are using Parentpay please make sure that you use "2019-20 Curriculum Enrichment".

Ringswell Avenue

We had an incident this week where a number of children and adults were soaked by a car driving too fast through the puddle that unfortunately accumulates on Ringswell Avenue during bad weather. If you are driving down the Avenue please take care, consider pedestrians and drive with caution through this deep puddle.

Outdoor Play
