Parking and Driving on Ringswell Avenue

Once again we ask for you to have care and consideration for our neighbours on Ringswell Avenue when driving to park and collect your children.

- Please find other places to park other than Ringswell Avenue and avoid the stress of finding a parking place.
- Please do not park in the school car park unless you have a permit. Staff members are often having to wait for spaces in the morning.
- Please do NOT reverse into neighbour's driveways when turning your car.
- Please do NOT block neighbour's driveways when parking to collect your children.
- Please do NOT drive on the pavement. A white Vauxhall car drove at speed on the pavement recently to gain access to Ringswell Avenue. This is illegal, dangerous and unacceptable. We have given the registration number to the police.
- We are working with the Police to try to lessen such inconsiderate actions and all registration numbers will be reported to them.
