#### **Uniform**

It is always lovely to see children looking so smart at the start of the new school year. Could we just remind you that school shoes should be worn (not trainers or boots) and that long hair (beyond shoulder length) should be tied back. Jewellery is not to be worn apart from stud earrings. We will continue to allow children to come into school wearing their PE kits on the days that they have PE lessons. Children should wear their PE kit (Green shorts or dark tracksuit bottoms) with a school jumper or fleece. Colourful hoodies are not permitted. Your child's class teacher will inform you of the PE days.

### **Parking**

The school car park is for staff and families that have been granted a parking permit only. We renew our permits annually in September. If you have a disabled blue badge please email in for your permit for this year. If you do not have a blue badge but you or your child have a medical reason for requiring a parking space, please complete the form below to request a permit. Due to an increased demand for permits and the limited number of spaces, we will be asking for medical evidence (where there is no blue badge) before granting any permits. Applications for a car park permit should be made via this form. All old permits for 21/22 should be returned to the school office.

#### Clubs

The staff of St Nicholas have come together to consider how we can enrich the experiences of the children beyond what is taught in lessons. With this in mind, different staff will run various clubs over the school year. Keep your eyes open for an overview of what's on offer. Individual staff members will send further information out regarding their club at the appropriate time.
