Covid Update

With effect from Friday 1 April 2022, Covid-19 guidance changed, as we continue to transition from numerous restrictions to living with Covid-19.

GUIDANCE CHANGE - From 1st April:

Anyone with a POSITIVE test result is advised to try and stay at home and avoid contact with other people for the period they are deemed most infectious, which is:

• 3 days for those aged UNDER 18 years

• 5 days for those aged 18 years or OVER

Help! I have no tests...how do I know if I need to isolate?

From 1st April, anyone who is experiencing symptoms of a respiratory infection (including Covid-19) and a high temperature, or who feels unwell, is advised to try and stay at home and avoid contact with other people, until they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to resume normal activities.

Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people as much as they can. They can return to school and/or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature and are well enough to attend.
